

Rodenticide Information

Client Information Sheet There are several different techniques used to control pests in your premises. All monitoring points should be left in position and not touched by anyone apart from a qualified technician employed by EPM Ltd. Toxic pesticides may have been used in these premises and can cause serious harm to humans or non-target animals if they have been misused or taken accidentally.

Please follow the procedures below if accidental poisoning occurs.

Accidental poisoning of humans

First Aid:

- ☉ Immediately arrange for the victim to be transported to a hospital.
- ☉ Remove the victim from any contaminated area.
- ☉ Loosen all clothing, especially around the neck and waist.
- ☉ Keep the victim warm and quiet and do not leave alone.
- ☉ Be prepared to administer artificial respiration.
- ☉ Have the treatment report left by the EPM Ltd technician available. At the bottom it will state the pesticides used and the active ingredient.

Accidental poisoning of animals

Treatment of animals after accidental poisoning must be carried out by a qualified veterinarian.

In emergencies, before expert help is available, induce vomiting in cats and dogs by giving a small quantity of washing soda.
